This bid shall be in effect from until covering any Proceed Orders issued by County during that time frame.
Sealed bids will be received by the County Commission at until AM Central Time on, and then publicly opened as soon thereafter as practicable. Award will be made at the next regularly scheduled meeting of the County Commission. Only bids from contractors or material suppliers listed on the Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT) approved list of contractors and material suppliers will be accepted.
